WRESTLING CLUB/MEETING MINUTES

I. APPOINTMENTS/ELECTIONS: None

II. ROLL/CALL TO ORDER: Commenced at 4:15pm at the Texas Roadhouse Restaurant in Lansing, the meeting completed at Lansing Community College in the Gannon Vo-Tec building before the start of the club's 1st semester fundraiser. MEMBER REPORTS: William Vincent (Treasurer), gave an update on his hand, it being diagnosed as a "hairline fracture" by doctor, and out for a few months, but then planning on returning to compete with team. His girlfriend Kelsey Philburn was present, and volunteered to help team during the entire fundraiser this day at the LCC volleyball last home game.

Shane Tisdale – Coordinator, spoke about the possibility of future, monthly fundraisers, upcoming projects with bleachers at the facility, & upcoming tournaments.

Dr. Ball was pleased, as seeing all members of the club that were athletes out to work the fundraiser together, to get in on a group picture, meet Scott Latham, LCC's director of Athletics, and more. Dr. Ball followed up after this event with an offer for an additional fundraiser on Oct 31st at the college for the club, but with restrictions on what could be sold if club was interested, beyond all the other offers from athletics to do future home events, and even up thru summer!

VII. OLD BUSINESS: Pre-season conditioning & training camp complete, LCC Wrestling Club Coordinator ordered t-shirts for all participants that survived the entire thing, and requested full participation from everyone in the club at monthly fundraisers to afford to reimburse himself for the purchase of these shirts, plus the club's remaining balance of singlets needed (x6) for all other remaining slot openings = \$599.99 to Johnny Mac's, plus the club's annual league renewal fee to NCWA of \$400 more, paid in monthly installments till paid off, at about \$100 month, starting immediately for first payment reimbursement, already remitted.

Motion passed/unanimously, all agreed that between participating at all fundraisers besides the Oct 31st one on Halloween, that they would be ready and knowing that they must complete at least one per month to be able to afford the things needed to be a participating wrestling club on campus, but also importantly within the NCWA league they wanted to re-join and resume with.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS: Members voted at practice unanimously to not participate in the Oct 31, 2011 fundraiser back at LCC due to specifications on which could be sold, and how.

Motion/resolution – denied/not passed, unanimously. With bleachers commenced, all were briefed that each Friday between meetings, would be work on these same bleachers till installed, at least first section/column through season

IX. OPEN COMMENT: Coordinator Shane Tisdale and Advisor Dr. Mike Ball, after speaking with the LCC Athletic Director in his office (Scott Latham), returned to additionally brief all on the possibilities of getting approved for future fundraisers at home, even up through softball/baseball seasons, working additional event concessions like SMA/AMA, & or first home dual possible for Feb 18, on campus (Sat.), 2012 for LCC Wrestling Club, quad, or small team tournament!
